MetroWest Boston boasts a large number of unique and interesting offsite meeting venues, from museums to historic properties to an indoor amusement park, including:

American Heritage Museum

568 Main St, Hudson, MA 01749

- American Heritage Museum Main Gallery: Approx 11,000 sq ft of event space (Museum is 50,000 sq ft total with exhibits) situated around 95 tanks, military vehicles, and large artifacts in a theatrically lit space. Seated capacity from 50-300 persons with installed video projection system for large presentations. Year-round, climate controlled facility with restrooms.
- American Heritage Museum Conference Room: 500 sq ft post and beam conference room with board room seating for 14 people. Large glass boardroom table made from WWII biplane wing. Installed 52" LCD monitor with sound and PC for presentations. Climate controlled with access to main museum.
- Aircraft Hangar: 11,000 sq ft of event space on ground floor, additional 3,200 sq ft of event space on entry/mezzanine level. Main floor features 12-14 historic aircraft from 1909-1945 and 3rd floor features collection of rare Sprint race cars and Indy Cars from the 1930's through 1990's. Seated capacity for up to 100 on mezzanine level and up to 300 on ground floor. Facility is seasonal with no climate control and requires additional portable restrooms for guests. Large 80' hangar doors can be opened for beautiful view of grass airfield along the Assabet River.
- Outdoor & Tented Spaces: The large 100+ acre campus allows many options for tented events from intimate 20-50 person gatherings at the stepped gardens and pergola to 400-person tented gatherings on the expansive 2200' grass airfield bordered by the Assabet River. Grass parking is available for over 200 guest vehicles. Tents are available from 3rd party contractors and are not pre-installed.
